Air Tour

O'AHU



Learn how the United States entered WWII and pay your respects to the thousands who lost their lives on December 7, 1941. Pearl Harbor Visitors Center is the largest visitor attraction on the island of O'ahu, with museums, galleries, and exhibits.

MAUI



The Road to Hana is voted one of the most scenic drives in the USA. With 617 hairpin turns and 54 one-lane bridges, you will make a day out of viewing the waterfalls, rainbow eucalyptus trees, cliff sides, and black sand beaches. Enjoy this by taking a guided tour or up in a helicopter.
